

## Nelson Mandela Provincial Teacher Development Institute Courses (Port Elizabeth): October 2020

**What is the nature and focus of the courses?** Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, all these courses, offered from 26 to 30 October 2020, are virtual. These courses address Reading (Languages); Mathematics (Content and problem solving) Natural Sciences (Content) and Technology (Content).

**Will trainees be assessed?** Yes: trainees will be assessed in a pre- and post-test related directly to the content of the course to ascertain the impact of the training on their subject knowledge.

**Who should attend?** Subject Advisors / Heads of Department / Teachers responsible for the specific grade/ phase and subject being targeted.

**Why should I attend?** Trainees who completed provincial courses during 2018/9 had the following to say:

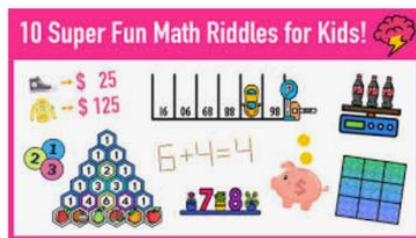
- *I came back with a positive attitude to my subject.*

- *I learnt how to deal with different ability levels in my class.*
- *I learnt different teaching strategies and how to integrate technology in my lessons.*
- *I gained deeper insight into Organic Chemistry.*
- *We were able to link mathematics and science in the projectile graph.*

**How many can attend?** 1 group of up to 80 trainees (per District) for each course listed in the Prospectus for the October 2020 school holidays.

**Training at the Nelson Mandela Provincial Teacher Development Institute:** This institute, based in Port Elizabeth, serves the training needs of the Nelson Mandela Metro, Sarah Baartman and Amathole West districts. However, for this training some facilitators will present their part of the course from their districts.

**When are the courses taking place?** This training will take place during the special October 2020 school holidays and will be not more than 5 hours per day. Training will take place virtually via Microsoft Teams. Trainees will register with their allocated registered departmental e-mail address, which will then be credited with the allocated data to participate in the training.
