

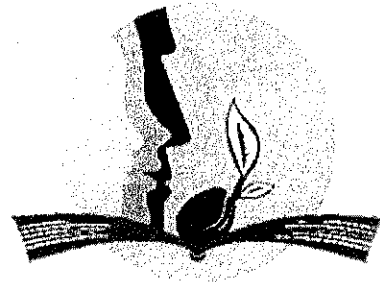



Applicants are reminded to bring along the following documents:

A. REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:

Professionally, Unprofessionally qualified educators and Student-educators.

1. Application form (which will be provided to you if you did not download it).
2. ID copy (Both sides if it is a smart ID card).
3. Matric certificate.
4. Junior Qualification, i.e., Diploma/Degree certificate.
5. Professional Teaching Qualification.
6. Academic record on the HEI's letterhead, signed and stamped indicating that the qualification has been completed and the date of completion.
7. Current Proof of Registration with the HEI if still studying for a PGCE.

NB. All the above-mentioned documents must be certified with the certification date not older than six months at the time of submission to SACE.

8. Proof of Payment if deposited into the SACE banking account or use your bank card for on the spot payment.

R200 SA citizens and R400 for Non-SA citizens.

No cash payment will be accepted at the registration station.

9. Verifiable Police clearance certificate which is not older than six months at the time of submission.

B. NON-SA CITIZENS

1. Certified valid Passport and Permit.
2. Permit valid for six months or more at the time of submission.
3. Conditions of the permit should allow the applicant to teach in SA.
4. Verifiable Police clearance certificate not older than six months at the time of submission.

C. SAQA EVALUATION REPORT

The evaluation report is needed for all qualifications received outside of the Republic of South Africa including the matric certificate.
