2nd CHANCE MATRIC SUPPORT PROGRAMME 2018

1. *Curriculum Instruction* F10/2018 refers to: The management and implementation of the 2nd Chance Matric Support Programme in the Eastern Cape for 2018.
2. The National Senior Certificate (NSC) is generally understood as a basic requirement for all learners in order to proceed to further education opportunities.
3. The objective of the Second Chance Matric Programme is assist all learners who have chosen the Multiple Examination Opportunity (MOE) route in 2017/18 with additional support so that they can obtain their National Senior Certificate (NSC) which will be written in May / June in 2018.
4. The Programme will give support to:
 - Progressed learners sitting for the modularised NSC (2018) ; and
 - Individuals who failed to meet the requirements of the NSC and the extended Senior Certificate (SC).
5. Progressed Learners (MOE) were allowed multiple opportunities in the writing of the National Senior Certificate examination, in order to ensure that he/she satisfies



the requirements of the NSC, which is conditional to the shelf life of the candidates School Based Assessment (SBA). They will sit for the Mid - Year exam during June annually and the remainder of the subjects during October /November annually.

6. The current cohort of Grade 12 MOE learners will be informed that the Second Chance Programme will offer face – to – face support in the 11 gateway subjects for both phases:

- Accounting
- Business Studies
- Economics
- Geography
- Life Sciences
- Mathematics
- Mathematical Sciences
- Physical Sciences
- Agricultural Sciences
- English FAL
- History

7. VENUES

- The Province has established one 2nd Chance Face-to-Face venue in all 12 districts.

16. ADVOCACY, MONITORING AND SUPPORT


- Distribution of Advocacy Material (posters and pamphlets)
