REMOTE LEARNING - 2022 VIRTUAL LESSON BROADCASTS

- 1 . The purpose of this E-Teaching and Learning Instruction is to inform schools of the availability of Provincial Virtual Lessons Broadcasts for Grade12 learners.
- 2. The virtual lessons in support of Grade 12 cohort will commence as from 01 August 2022 till 21 September 2022.
- 3. The virtual lessons aim to prepare Grade 12 learners for the September Preparatory Examinations (Trial Examination).

- 4. The presenters for these lessons are either Subject Advisors or selected lead teachers in specific subjects.
- 5. Lessons are streamed through a VLC app downloadable from the app stores and through TEAMS.
- 6. The lessons in 2022 will also be accessible through ecdoe facebook page and the you tube channel.
- 7. This virtual classroom makes it possible to reach a large number of learners and provide them with quality individual tutoring.

- 9. The lessons will be broadcasted from 14:00-17:00 from Monday till Friday- see Annexure A for the Broadcasting Schedule attached.
- 10. To access the broadcasted lessons, learners are expected to download a VLC App (this is an icon that depicts the form of an orange cone) from the app store/ play store.
- 11. Note that lessons will also be broadcasted through **Microsoft TEAMS** and link for the lessons has been shared in the table below.
- 12. Enter the links provided below for a broadcasting site for a specific subject and it will be ready for viewing live or recorded.
