## Deadline for Mid-Year Examination Registration extended to 18 February 2019

*"Due to immense interest in the mid-year examination offering, the Department of Basic Education has extended the registration deadline to 18 February 2019.*

*"The Department has been inundated with requests from those who missed the January 31st deadline and still want to register.*

*"Learners who are still hoping to register for the Amended Senior Certificate (ASC) examinations or the National Senior Certificate (NSC) examinations need to visit their nearest district education office before the 18th of February to register.*

*"We encourage those who are interested to not leave it to the last minute to apply as the Department will not be able to accommodate another extension of the registration period due to logistical reasons.*

*"These examinations will be written in May/June 2019 and will give learners a Second Chance to get their matric certificate. This opportunity is for those learners who had previously failed their Matric, or perhaps only need to write one or two subjects to qualify for their Matric. Learners who want to improve their results are welcome to register as well.*

*"Learners who had previously dropped out of school and are now over 21 years of age will need to present the results of the highest grade they have passed, provided they have passed at least Grade 9, and they too can have a Second Chance opportunity to attain their matric certificate."*

# Ithuthuko now offers SACE endorsed courses online!

## Earn SACE endorsed CPTD points online (PR13378)

As is the case with other professions, we are all aware of and support the efforts from SACE to up the professional image of teachers by enforcing the completion of professional development through various means to obtain continuous development points every year. Since 2018 all teachers must comply with the required 150 CPTD points over 3 years.

We designed a practical system to support you to assist your teachers to comply and to complete their SACE CPTD points in their own time. We understand the pressure of teachers and designed the system so that it will not add stress to the life of teachers. They will be able to complete their training in the comfort of their houses. Ithuthuko (meaning: education) in collaboration with experts in the field, have put together an online SACE approved platform which will enable teachers to complete their CPTD points anywhere, any time. No more traveling to workshops, taking teachers out of the classrooms and sacrificing holidays. Our system supports your teachers to do their training in 2 hours and receive 5 CPTD registered points! No administration, we will do that on your behalf!

The Ithuthuko system will keep you and your teachers fully informed of their progress in completing their SACE registered CPTD points. Once the school signed up, Ithuthuko will send a monthly report which shows the progress of the teachers. You can use this in staff meetings to manage, guide and motivate teachers to complete their CPTD points. The same report will be sent to SACE, to ensure that teachers' CPTD points are continuously updated.

Together with the SACE office, we have carefully selected the course topics to ensure they are relevant and add value to the teachers' day to day activities. Our course content owners are experienced experts in the field.

Courses are grouped to address and support the following skills:

- Leadership development (5 courses)
- Psycho social challenges in the classroom (6 courses)

How do you sign-up your school? To benefit your school, up to 30 April 2019 your school only pay the registration fee of the first 25 teachers. This registration fee entails **R1380-00 per** teacher per year to do their 50 SACE registered CPTD points. All your teachers will however be registered on the Ithuthuko platform to give them access to the course material. To ensure flexibility and choice, the teachers will have access to content of 90 CPTD, SACE registered courses.

The access to the 90 CPTD SACE registered points, implies they have the option to select any 50 which is relevant to their work environment. The Ithuthuko platform will register the teacher's first 50 CPTD points with SACE per annum. In year 2 they need to register again and there will be additional courses available to ensure that they do not have to repeat the same courses but have access to more and interesting courses. We will also appreciate your feedback during the year to ensure that we enrich the pool of content writers to make sure the courses offered are relevant and helpful to the teachers taking the time to work through them.

What will we require from you following the registration fees of the teachers?

The list of names of teachers, email addresses, their SACE numbers and ID numbers as required by SACE, we will register them on the platform and every teacher will receive and email with their login details, a copy will also be sent to the school. Please again note that if you have more than 25 SACE registering teachers, we need the particulars of all teachers to ensure their registration – remember you only pay for the first 25 teachers to enroll from your school.

The aim of our effort is to support you and SACE to maintain the professional standard of teaching in South Africa.
