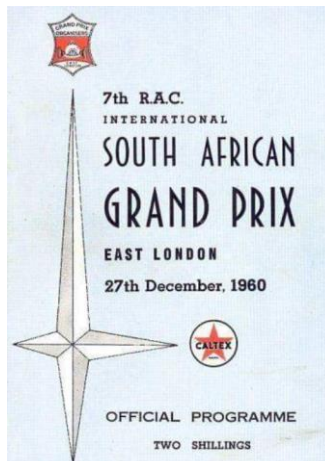
Announcements by Minister Motshekga

Proudly Eastern Cape: Formula 1 Racing



*"Petrol in my hare, petrol in my oë
en koue, koue Caltex in my voet..."*

Só het George Louw liries geraak oor iemand met moed vir spoed. En wie is daar wat meer versot is op spoed as Formule Een-(F1-) renjaers? Amper elke tweede week kan ons ons verwonder aan die mooi motors, snelhede van tot 360 km/h, die vaardighede van die renjaers, die blitsige herstelwerk in die kuipe – en soms skouspelagtige ongelukke. Dis nogal ironies dat dit hoofsaaklik die ongelukke is wat as hoogtepunte aan ons opgedis word tydens TV-nuusbulletins.

F1 is die duurste sportsoort wat daar is. Gelukkig baat baie daarby en nie net die goedbetaalde, adrenaliënverslaafde renjaers nie. Die land wat dit aanbied, kry 'n stewige ekonomiese inspuiting. As jy iemand is wat daarvan hou om na die wedrenne op TV te kyk, weet dan jy is nie alleen nie: daar is ongeveer 55 miljoen ander geesdriftiges wat saam met jou kyk! Maar uiteindelik baat alle motorgebruikers ook by die sportsoort, want dis juis tydens hierdie wedrenne waar alle motorprodukte getoets word en dit wat hierdie strawwe toetse slaag, word in ons gewone motors gebruik.

Al ooit gewonder wanneer het F1-wedrenne begin? Wel, die spoedrate is al lankal met ons, want dit was glad nie lank nadat motors uitgevind is nie! Die eerste motorwedren is reeds in 1895 tussen Parys en Bordeaux aangebied. Die eerste Grand Prix-wedren is in 1901 in Frankryk aangebied en die heel eerste Grand Prix in Suid-Afrika is in 1934 in Oos-Londen gehou. Dit was die geval tot in die 60's en dis interessant om te weet dat hierdie baan steeds deur motorsportentoesiaste gebruik word.

In die 70's is die Suid-Afrikaanse Grand Prix na Kyalami verskuif totdat sankies in 1985 'n einde gebring het aan ons F1-deelname. Sedert die nuwe Suid-Afrika tot stand gekom het, het ons weer twee keer 'n kans gekry om 'n Grand Prix aan te bied – die laaste keer in 1993. (’n Grand Prix is ’n wedren wat deel vorm van die reeks F1-wedrenne wat die wêreldkampioen bepaal.) Al hierdie interessante brokkies, asook nuus oor die huidige reeks, is beskikbaar by <http://www.f1-grandprix.com/history1.html> en http://af.wikipedia.org/wiki/Formule_Een.

Suid-Afrika het nie net vantevore Grand Prix-wedrenne aangebied nie, maar daar het selfs 'n wêreldkampioen uit ons geledere gekom, naamlik Jody Scheckter. Hy het in Oos-Londen grootgeword en het baie tyd op die reeds genoemde renbaan deurgebring. Hy het in 1972 aan Grand Prix-wedrenne begin deelneem en het stadig maar seker sy stempel daarop afgedruk. In 1979 het hy vir Ferrari gejaag en dieselfde jaar is hy gekroon as die wêreldkampioen! Dit was eers 21 jaar later dat Ferrari

George Louw became lyrical about someone with a need for speed. And who is more fond of speed than Formula One (F1) drivers? Almost every second week we can enjoy the beautiful cars, speed of up to 360 km/h, the skills of the drivers, the speedy repairs - and sometimes spectacular accidents. It is quite ironic that it is mainly the accidents that are reported to us as highlights during TV news bulletins.

F1 is the most expensive sport there is. Fortunately, all of us benefit a lot and not just the well-paid, adrenaline addicted drivers. The hosting country get a very good economic injection. If you are someone who likes watching the races on TV, then you are not alone: there are about 55 million other enthusiasts watching with you! But ultimately, all car users benefit from the sport as it is during these races where all car products are tested. Developments that stood the test of time are then used in ordinary vehicles.

Have you ever wondered when F1 racing started? Well, the speedsters have been with us for a long time, because it started not long after cars were invented! The first car race took place between Paris and Bordeaux in 1895. The first Grand Prix race was held in France in 1901 and the first Grand Prix in South Africa was held in East London in 1934. This was the case until the 60s and it is interesting to know that this track is still being used by sports enthusiasts.

In the 70s, the South African Grand Prix was moved to Kyalami until 1985 when it was the end of our F1 participation. Since the establishment of the new South Africa, we once again had a chance to host a Grand Prix - the last time in 1993. (A Grand Prix is a race that forms part of the F1 series of the world championship.) South Africa has not only hosted Grand Prix races before, but even a world champion came from our ranks, Jody Scheckter. He grew up in East London and spent a lot of time on the already mentioned race track. He started participating in Grand Prix races in 1972 and slowly but surely printed his mark on it. In 1979 he raced for Ferrari and the same year he was crowned the world champion! It was only 21 years later that Ferrari could again have a world champion - with Michael Schumacher behind the wheel!

Vroue-renjaers is so skaars soos hoendertande. Slegs vyf vroue kon tot op hede kwalifiseer om aan 'n Grand Prix-wedren deel te neem en een van hulle was Desiree Wilson van Suid-Afrika! Desiree is tot op hede die enigste vrou wat nog ooit 'n F1-wedren kon wen, naamlik die Britse F1-kampioenskap in 1980. Een van hul pawiljoene is daarna na haar vernoem.

Ten slotte 'n bietjie insiggewende raad deur die einste Michael Schumacher aan alle ouers ten opsigte van die ondersteuning van kinders: *“My overriding memory of childhood is having the freedom to decide which way to go in life and having my parents' support.”*

Women racing drivers are very scarce: Only five women have entered at least one Grand Prix, although only two of them ever qualified and started a race. One of them was Desiree Wilson of South Africa! Until now Desiree has been the only woman to ever win an F1 race, namely the British F1 championship in 1980. As a result of this achievement, she has a grandstand at Brands Hatch named after her.

Finally, a little informative advice by the very Michael Schumacher to all parents regarding the support of children: *“My overriding memory of childhood is having the freedom to decide which way to go in life and having my parents' support.”*
