Extension of contract for the Unemployed Youth

In response to the devastating economic effects of the Covid-19 pandemic His Excellency President Cyril Ramaphosa came up with the Presidential Employment Stimulus.

The Presidential Employment Stimulus was seeking to confront the impact of Covid-19 directly, as part of government broader economic recovery agenda.

The Department of Basic Education submitted a funding request which was then approved through the Education Employment Initiative Grant.

The Eastern Cape Department of Education was then given a go ahead to recruit 55 803 unemployed youth as Education Assistants (EAs) and General School Assistants (GSAs) across the Province.

Indeed, the Province successfully recruited the 55 803 unemployed youth who assumed their duties on 1 December last year (2020) on a four (4) months contract.

Although there were challenges with capturing and payment processes which caused a lot of discomfort, the Department worked tirelessly to rectify and address those challenges.

The four months contract on the 31st of March 2021 will be coming to an end BUT the Department saw the need to revisit this contract and negotiate with DBE to further EXTEND this contract by a month.

This therefore means that the contract will now end on the 30 April 2021.

Principals and schools are requested NOT to replace any EAs or GSAs who would have resigned from their contracts.

Last year we had 3 similar <u>tournaments</u> with over 1000 learners from 400 schools participating.

It is sponsored by Amazon Web Services [#AWSInCommunities] in promotion of the AWS Tech Week (see at bottom of email) at the end of April.

The Tech Week is a great online event for children of all ages.

Incentives

Prizes include the following: Tablet for the top scoring learner

1 GB free data for the Top 30 Learners

The top 8 participating schools / NGO's win either a TANKS or BOATS School Kit (they choose)

4 Primary and 4 High Schools will go through to the next round with total cash prizes worth R10000.00

How does it work?

- The school registers its participation at this LINK by Wednesday 14 April
 - There is no cost involved to schools or learners
- On Thursday 15 April we send participating schools a flyer to forward to their learners (either printed, by email or WhatsApp).
 - \circ $\;$ This flyer will guide them on how to participate using the BOATS app
 - Learners play individually from anywhere

- They need no prior coding knowledge to be competitive 0
- Scores are submitted from their phones to a central database
- There are no limits on how many times they play

The BOATS app

The latest version of the app will be available by latest next Thursday. In addition to basic coding concepts, it also has an environmental theme. Consequently learners will be educated on Marine Pollution and Renewable Energy Learners are welcome to start practicing on the app : "BOATS powered by Tangibl" on Google PlayStore

But for the tournament, they must download the new version end of next week.

BOATS School Kit

This coding kit is aimed at Grade R to 3 learners, introducing coding through physical activities and the BOATS app. It includes 10 lesson plans for teachers, and various colourful resources

TANKS School Kit

This coding kit is aimed at **Grade 4 and older learners**, introducing coding through physical activities and the TANKS app. It includes 7 lesson plans, and 8 TANKS game sets.
