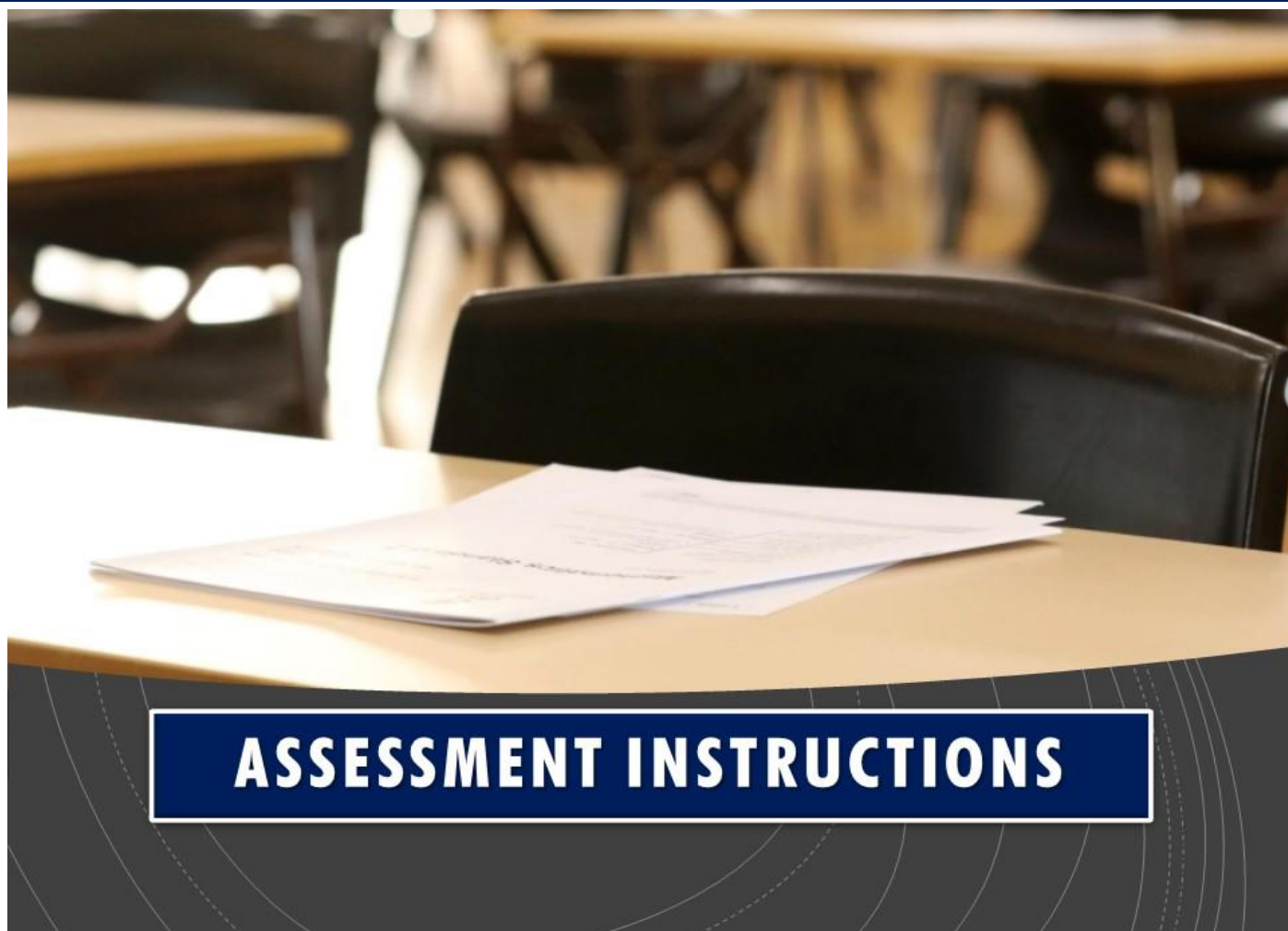

Minister Motshekga aligns education priorities to 2022 SONA

Basic Education Minister, Mrs Angie Motshekga, this week, responded to the State of the Nation Address (SONA) during a joint sitting in Cape Town from 14 to 16 February 2022. The Minister reflected on specific issues, which arose on the role of basic education in repositioning South Africa on an inclusive growth path. “At the Basic Education Lekgotla held two weeks ago, it was resolved that the sector will be rebooted, recalibrated and repositioned to withstand the debilitating impact of COVID-19, and any other crises schooling may face,” the Minister said.

The function shift of Early Childhood Development (ECD) from Social Development to the Department Basic Education (DBE) will be taking place on 1 April 2022 to strengthen learning foundations. “To respond to challenges related to learner dropout, we have introduced strategic measures to assist vulnerable learners, who are at risk. Three interventions include learner progression; the Second Chance Matric Support Programme, and a variety of psychosocial programmes. The return to normal time-tabling will assist the sector to intensify its implementation of the curriculum recovery plan. On curriculum, we agreed that to equip learners with 21st century skills, and facilitate an efficient transition from school to work, the Department must embark on a curriculum strengthening process. In addition, the DBE must set minimum standards for teacher competencies and strengthen the coordination of Teacher Development Programmes. The availability of high speed broadband is no longer a luxury, but a necessity for schools, to

leverage on the benefits that technology can add to the delivery of quality basic education.”

The Basic Education Sector benefitted from the Presidential Youth Employment Intervention (PYEI), through which 595 000 employment opportunities were created for young people in public schools across the country during 2021 and will remain a flagship component of the PYEI.

“We were encouraged when the President announced that Government is introducing an innovative social infrastructure delivery mechanism to address issues that affect the delivery of school infrastructure. The mechanism will address the speed, financing and funding, quality of delivery, mass employment and the maintenance of school infrastructure. School infrastructure remains a major challenge and The Presidential Infrastructure Programme is therefore welcomed.”

“We must ramp up the performance in all the four phases our schooling system; we must continue to improve the reading proficiency of our learners; we must work harder, but smarter with our partners to consolidate the gains we have made in the Skills Revolution through the Three-Stream Curriculum Model and the Fourth Industrial Revolution and we must continue to strengthen the assessment regime in all four phases of the system.”

Minister Motshekga added. “With the involvement and support of communities in schools, levels of vandalism and crime in the schools, as well as social ills such as bullying, gender-based violence, and learner pregnancies can be reduced at schools, the Basic Education system has begun to reach the desired stability and the unquestionable resilience our school communities have shown against such a devastating pandemic,” the Minister concluded.
