- 1. This memo serves as communication on the implementation of Quality Management System (QMS) for Post levels 2- 4 school based educators.
- 2. The 2022 assessment year marks the implementation of the new QMS instrument for all school based educators.
- 3. The department has successfully trained its Principals and educators in preparation of the implementation of the new QMS instrument.
- Implementation of the new QMS instrument is meant to have a clear, coherent policy and regulatory environment for both teacher appraisal and teacher development.
- All Post levels 2 4 (Principals, Deputy Principals and HOD's) are required to sign Work Plans using the new approved instrument with their immediate supervisors.
- 6. As we implement the new QMS instrument the department would like to ensure that the QMS instrument is implemented effectively and effectively.







- All Districts are to ensure that Circuit managers are stationed under one roof for the signing of the Work Plans.
- Districts are requested to come up with Management Plans on the signing of the Work Plans and the contracting management plan **MUST NOT** go beyond the 15th of February 2022.
- 9. All District HRD offices are requested to collate all signed Work Plans and keep both physical documents and scanned documents to ensure that all Work Plans are readily available.
- 10. Contracting on the new QMS instrument will be done physically as it is going to be taken as a continuous training of educators on the implementation of the new QMS instrument.
- 11. All NTT and PTT members in each district are requested to monitor and support the contracting process.
- 12. All District QMS management plans are to be submitted to the Acting Director HRD not later than 24 January 2022.
