



22nd Edition NATIONAL TEACHING Awards

BACKGROUND

The National Teaching Awards (NTA) is part of Teacher Appreciation and Support Programme (TASP) which was launched by the Minister of Basic Education in 2015. The major goal of TASP programme is to acknowledge, appreciate and celebrate the teacher excellence in diverse contexts.

CATEGORIES

Three (3) Special categories of the 22nd NTA will be conducted nationally on an online/digital platform.

1. National Best Teacher Award;
2. SHERO Award; and
3. National Learner Award.

EXCELLENCE AWARDS

The process for these categories must start at school level then proceed to district, cluster, province until winners reached the final phase of the selection of winners by a National Adjudication Panel. Each individual teacher and/or team can volunteer their names for nomination.

DATES: Nominations are open from
28 March until 22 April 2022.

**NB: Districts are not allowed to select
candidates directly from schools.**

- Excellence in Secondary School Leadership;
- Excellence in Special Needs Teaching;
- Excellence in Teaching Mathematics (GET);
- Excellence in Teaching Mathematics (FET);
- Excellence in Teaching Natural Sciences;
- Excellence in Teaching Physical Sciences;
- Excellence in Technology-Enhanced, Teaching and Learning Award;
- Kader Asmal Lifetime Achievement Award
