## **REMOTE LEARNING - 2021 VIRTUAL LESSON BROADCASTS**

1 . The purpose of this E-Teaching and Learning Instruction is to inform schools of the availability of Provincial Virtual Lessons Broadcasts for Grade12 learners.

- 2. The virtual lessons commenced in March 2020 October 2020 to support Grade 12 learners through broadcasted lessons.
- 3. The broadcasted lessons will once again resume from the 10 August-22 September 2021, to prepare Grade 12 learners for the September Preparatory Examinations (Trial Examination).
- 4. The presenters for these lessons are either Subject Advisors or selected lead teachers in specific subjects.
- 5. Lessons are streamed through a VLC app downloadable from the app stores.
- 6. This virtual classroom makes it possible to reach a large number of learners and provide them with quality individual tutoring.

- 10. Note that lessons will also be broadcasted through Microsoft TEAMS and link for the lessons will be shared with schools by E-Learning coordinators and Subject Advisors.
