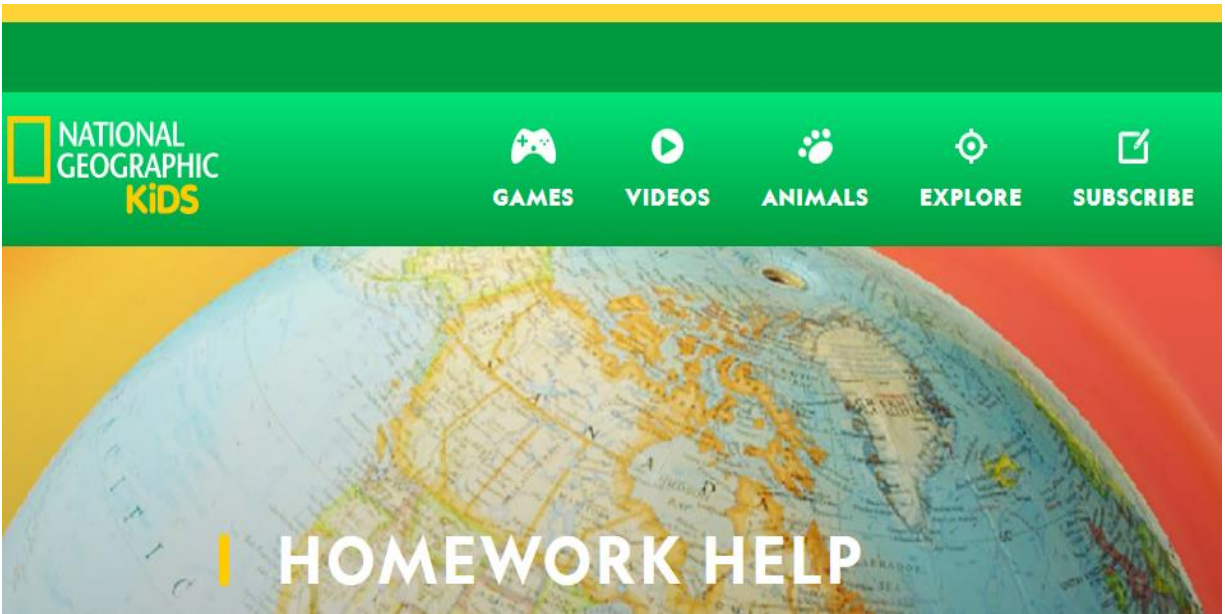

Where did it all start?

In the late 1990s, I started sending information via email to schools in the East London district. At that time I was still using a super slow dial-up connection.

Over time, schools from other districts also asked to receive the emails. Schools also started advertising vacant temporary and governing body posts and prospective teachers sent their resumes for distribution.

Gradually the number of emails increased so much that in 2014 I decided to put them together in a newsletter and so the **Hoor hier** was established.

Currently, **Hoor hier** is published twice a week and about 90 issues are published per year.
