HOOR HIER: DON'T LOSE YOUR CLASS!

Don't lose your class #1: Ideas for creating and maintaining a positive classroom culture

- Build positive relationships with students by getting to know them as individuals and showing a genuine interest in their lives outside of school.
- Establish clear expectations and rules for behaviour, and consistently enforce them in a fair and respectful manner.
- Use positive reinforcement to recognize and celebrate student accomplishments and positive behaviours, such as giving verbal praise or providing small rewards.



- Encourage student participation and engagement by creating opportunities for student choice and voice in classroom activities and discussions.
- Foster a **sense of community** in the classroom by promoting teamwork and collaboration and providing opportunities for students to work together and support one another.
- Create a safe and secure classroom environment by establishing routines and procedures, and addressing any issues or concerns related to student safety or well-being.
- **Support student diversity** and inclusion by incorporating diverse perspectives and experiences into classroom discussions and activities and promoting respect for all students.
- Use technology and other resources to enhance learning and create a more engaging and interactive classroom environment.
- Encourage a growth mindset in students by emphasizing the importance of effort, persistence, and resilience, and helping students develop a positive attitude toward learning.
- Model positive behaviour and attitudes as a teacher by demonstrating empathy, respect, and a positive outlook, and consistently holding yourself to high standards of professionalism and ethical conduct.




