DON'T LOSE YOUR CLASS BULLYING AND HARASSMENT

How teachers can handle bullying and harassment

Bullying and harassment can have serious negative impacts on students' well-being and academic performance. Teachers play a critical role in preventing and addressing these issues in the classroom and school.

This could be achieved through the following:

- Establish clear rules and expectations around appropriate behaviour, including consequences for bullying and harassment.
- Create a safe and inclusive classroom environment where all students feel respected and valued.
- Take all reports of bullying and harassment seriously and investigate them promptly.
- Use restorative practices to address bullying and harassment, including talking with the victim, the perpetrator, and any witnesses.
- Provide support and resources for students who have experienced bullying and harassment.
- Encourage bystander intervention and empower students to stand up against bullying and harassment.
- Use age-appropriate lessons and activities to educate students about the effects of bullying and harassment, and how to prevent it.
- Collaborate with parents and guardians to address incidents of bullying and harassment and develop strategies for prevention.
- Involve school counsellors, administrators, and other support staff as needed to address bullying and harassment.
- Document all incidents of bullying and harassment, including the date, time, location, and nature of the incident, as well as any witnesses and actions taken.
- Provide ongoing training and support for teachers on how to recognize, prevent, and address bullying and harassment.
- Ensure that all school staff are aware of the school's policies and procedures around bullying and harassment and are prepared to enforce them.
- Provide opportunities for students to give feedback on the school's efforts to prevent and address bullying and harassment.
- Regularly review and evaluate the school's policies and procedures around bullying and harassment to ensure that they are effective and up-to-date.
- Foster a culture of respect, empathy, and kindness in the classroom and throughout the school.

In conclusion, handling bullying and harassment in classrooms and schools requires a comprehensive approach that involves creating a safe and inclusive learning environment, educating students about the effects of bullying and harassment, and taking prompt action to address incidents when they occur. By working together, teachers, administrators, students, and families can help prevent bullying and harassment and promote a culture of respect and kindness in schools.

MANDELA DAY CODING TOURNAMENT

Mandela Day Coding Tournaments

I am happy to introduce you to the Mandela Day tournaments taking place across South Africa, as well as the rest of Africa, on 18 July 2023.

The bigger Tangible Africa project started in 2017 when a postgraduate student at Nelson Mandela University, Byron Batteson, developed the <u>TANKS</u> coding app. The purpose of the app has been from the start to introduce learners to coding concepts without the use of computers. The desperate shortage of software developers combined with the challenge of 1000's of schools who do not have computer laboratories, makes this project very relevant in South Africa.

Since 2017 the project, a collaboration between Nelson Mandela University and Leva Foundation, has reached nearly 100 000 learners, with coding kits being distributed to over 500 schools. The project is now also reaching out to the rest of Africa, with an initial footprint in Tanzania, Botswana, Zimbabwe, Zambia, Uganda, Kenya, Ghana, and Namibia.

Since July 2018 we have been presenting <u>coding tournaments</u> on Mandela Day, in various formats. Last year saw over 6000 learners participate at 50 sites across South Africa as well as in a few other African countries.

We are looking forward to as many as possible cities, townships and rural villages hosting tournaments.

The basic format of a tournament is as follows:

- Teams participate with 5 learners per team.
- The most general categories are Grades 6 and 7, and Grades 8 and 9.
- A tournament can have a minimum of 4 teams participating, with no maximum limit set.
- Participants are typically given 30-40 minutes to see how many levels of either TANKS or RANGERS they can complete. The team that has completed the most levels win.
- As sponsorships allow, Tangible Africa will provide funds to each site, mainly for incentives. Where critically needed, we will do our best to assist with other logistical costs.
- We also plan to provide some game packs beforehand for learners to practice with.




