

Mathematics or Mathematical Literacy?



At a national level, the question is often asked by policy makers: What should the ratio between Mathematics and Mathematical Literacy be? Should the top achievers in Mathematical Literacy not have taken Mathematics instead, given that Mathematics opens up far more opportunities?

Over the past 13 years, the proportion of learners taking Mathematics has steadily declined—from 48% in 2010 to 32% in 2023, meaning only one in every three learners now chooses Mathematics. The value of Mathematics is well recognised, and the value of Mathematical Literacy as a subject is not questioned either, as it clearly fills an important gap that existed before the subject was introduced.

However, learners face a challenge: Which one should they choose?

The decision between Mathematics and Mathematical Literacy is a critical one for learners in the FET Phase, as it influences future studies and career opportunities. Here's detailed advice to guide learners in making the best choice based on their abilities and career goals:

Mathematics

Mathematics focuses on abstract thinking, problem-solving, and logical reasoning. It is a challenging subject, but mastering it opens doors to a wide range of careers that require advanced numerical skills.

Career Paths for Mathematics:

- Science and Technology: Engineering, Computer Science, Data Science, IT, and Architecture.
- **Health Sciences:** Medicine, Pharmacy, Dentistry, and Veterinary Science.
- Commerce and Finance: Accounting, Actuarial Science, Investment Banking, and Economics.
- Education: Teaching Mathematics or Sciences at secondary and tertiary levels.

- Arts and Creative Fields: Graphic Design, Event Management,

Tourism, and Hospitality.

- Business and Administration: Human Resources, Marketing, and Office Management.
- Service Sectors: Police Services, Nursing, and Social Work.



Free support to prepare for primary school coding and robotics curricula

Teachers invited to register for Tangible Africa course

Herald Reporter

To ensure no teacher nor pupil is left behind in the ever-evolving world of technology, Tangible Africa has launched a free programme for 2025 to support teachers ahead of the upcoming coding and robotics curricula for primary schools.

Over the past three years, Tangible Africa has trained teachers across SA in unplugged coding, having reached more than 40,000 teachers using the flagship coding games BOATS and RANGERS in conjunction with lesson plans.

Tangible Africa global engagement manager Jackson Tshabalala said all teachers were invited to register for this course. Upon registration they will receive a sample lesson.

Teachers who give feedback on the implementation of the lessons stand to win a R5,000 lucky draw every term.

"We have committed to provide weekly lessons during the first term of 2025.

"The continuation and expansion of the project will depend on how many teachers register and implement the lessons in their classes," Tshabalala said.

Nelson Mandela University computing sciences associate professor and Tangible Africa founder Jean Greyling said all the initial lessons would be offline and interactive, focusing on the introduction of coding principles as well as problem solving.

The lesson plans are developed by award-winning East London-based teacher Kelly Bush.

"The unplugged lessons for Tangible Africa were aimed at assisting teachers in imparting crucial skills encompassing coding, computational thinking, design thinking, and digital citizenship, while also nurturing learners' abilities in co-operation, logical thinking, communication, critical and deductive thinking, as well as creativity and innovation.

"I am happy to see these pedagogical features are highlighted in the final document, which can be implemented in any setting, from the deep rural classrooms of Tsomo to schools that already have computer labs."

Tangible Africa future skills programme co-ordinator Lusanda Maqungo, from We Code Everywhere in Tsomo, was involved in tangible coding training that took place last year at schools from the Chris Hani East and Amathole Districts.

"I have trained hundreds of teachers in rural Eastern Cape in unplugged and tangible coding and found that teachers

have few challenges in understanding it.

"I have also seen that problem-solving skills are enhanced while doing this coding. It has a very positive impact on pupils' self-confidence as well as their performance in subjects like maths," Maqungo said.

Bronwen Jonson, a teacher at Summerwood Primary School in Gqeberha, said it was particularly exciting that Foundation Phase pupils would be able to learn the fundamentals of coding, through play. "Teaching the pupils from a young age to 'think about their thinking' is imperative.

"By implementing unplugged coding in the Foundation Phase, pupils all over SA will be able to be part of this initiative. It wouldn't only be something Quintile 5 schools will be able to afford to implement." Jonson said.

Swartkops Primary School's Victoria Olivier said the beauty of tangible coding was that it worked for any type of school.

"With tangible coding, it's so easy. You show the pupils what to do and allow them to run with it.

"It can be done anywhere at any time. To play the coding games, the only requirement is a phone that can download the app and data.

"Once the app is downloaded onto the phone, the pupils can challenge themselves at home."
