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Practical Lessons from Financial Mismanagement — The Principal's Responsibility

Sound financial management is the backbone of every well-functioning school. Yet, too often, reports of financial mismanagement make headlines, damaging the reputation of schools and eroding the trust of parents and the community. Beyond the embarrassment and potential legal consequences, these situations offer valuable lessons — particularly for principals, who carry the ultimate responsibility for the financial governance of their schools in terms of **Section 16A of the South African Schools Act (Act 84 of 1996)**.

The Principal's Mandate: Section 16A of the South African Schools' Act (SASA)

Section 16A clearly outlines the **duties and responsibilities of principals** as appointed by the Head of Department. It clearly defines the principal's duties beyond the professional management of the school, explicitly bringing financial oversight into their line of responsibility. Among these duties, the principal is required to ensure that all school resources are used effectively, responsibly, and transparently. This includes making sure that all financial records are kept properly and that the School Governing Body (SGB) operates within the law when handling school funds.

The principal's key financial duties, as outlined in Section 16A(2)(h), (i), and (j), are:

- Assisting the SGB with Fund Management (16A(2)(h)): The principal
 acts as the key technical advisor to the SGB, providing information on
 financial conditions issued by the Minister, MEC, or HOD, and advising
 the SGB on the financial implications of its decisions.
- Preventing Maladministration (16A(2)(i)): The principal must take all reasonable steps to prevent any financial maladministration or mismanagement by any staff member or the governing body itself. This is a proactive duty requiring constant vigilance and internal controls.
- Active Participation (16A(2)(j)): The principal must be a member of a finance committee or delegation of the governing body to ensure direct involvement in financial operations and decision-making.

In essence, even though the **SGB** is the accounting authority responsible for school finances, the principal acts as the professional manager and must ensure compliance with financial procedures. This dual accountability demands not only knowledge of policy but also daily vigilance and ethical leadership.

Common Pitfalls in Financial Management

Financial mismanagement at schools often arises not from deliberate corruption, but from **poor systems**, **lack of oversight**, **or ignorance of procedures**. Some common pitfalls include:

- Lack of ethical leadership by the principal
- Lack of Knowledge and Diligence:
 - The principal relies entirely on the SGB Treasurer or an outside bookkeeper, failing to properly scrutinise monthly financial reports or budgets, assuming the SGB has it covered. This is a direct failure of the advice and prevention duties in Section 16A.
 - SGB members, finance officers, and clerks lack capacity to do their work properly
- Blurred Lines of Authority: the SGB oversteps its governance role and interferes with the principal's *professional management* function, or the principal oversteps into the SGB's governance territory, leading to conflicts and a lack of accountability.
- Failure to follow procurement procedures and obtain proper quotations.
- Failing to Implement Proper Controls over petty cash and school fundraising income.: Money is collected by various staff (educators for excursions, secretaries for school fees) without a rigid, central system of reconciliation. Payments are made without proper documentation.

- Poor record-keeping and incomplete financial reports.
- Unauthorised expenditure or payments made without SGB approval.
- Poor Budgeting
- · Mixing personal and school funds, even temporarily.

Practical Lessons from Financial Pitfalls

- **Model ethical leadership:** The tone at the top matters. When a principal demonstrates honesty, transparency, and discipline in financial matters, it sets a clear standard for the entire school community.
- **Budgeting:** Draw up an accurate school budget. The key steps and tips on how to do it, is available **here.**
- Financial Literacy: The principal must be financially literate enough to understand the school's budget, financial statements, and relevant Head of Department: Education directions. They must actively *question* any unusual or high expenditure, and they should **never sign off** on a payment without verifying the underlying transaction **and** ensuring it aligns with the approved budget.
- Capacity building for all role-players: Many financial problems stem from a lack of training. Principals should ensure that SGB members, finance officers, and clerks receive ongoing training in financial management and compliance.
- **Professional Bridge:** The principal represents the HOD and must act as the **professional bridge** between the Department and the SGB. They must **inform the SGB of legislation and policy** (16A(2)(f)). If the SGB is making a financially risky or non-compliant decision, the principal's duty under Section 16A(2)(i) is to formally raise the issue and document it for the sake of prevention.
- Policies and Procedures: Establish clear procedures and stick to them.
 Every school should have a clear financial policy aligned with provincial
 guidelines. Principals must ensure that all staff understand and follow it
 consistently.
- Internal Controls: The principal must ensure a robust system of internal controls is in place. This includes:
 - Implementing a segregation of duties—the person collecting cash shouldn't be the only one recording it or doing the bank reconciliation.
 - Insisting on the immediate issuing of official receipts for all money received.
 - There should be at least two signatories for the school's bank account: the principal and a member of the SGB.
 - Delegating authority in writing and ensuring all financial

transactions are supported by approved invoices, purchase orders, and proof of delivery.

Regular internal audits.

Principals should arrange for internal checks during the year, not only at the end of the financial period. These small reviews can detect errors early and reinforce accountability.

- **Transparency is non-negotiable:** Open communication about financial decisions builds trust. Present regular financial reports to the SGB, staff, and parents, and ensure that all transactions are traceable and properly documented.
- External Audits: External audits are vital for ensuring transparency, accountability, and good governance in schools. They provide an independent assessment of the school's financial records, confirming that funds have been used correctly and in line with legal and policy requirements. Regular external audits not only help to identify errors or irregularities early but also strengthen the trust between the school, parents, and the broader community. By promoting sound financial management, external audits safeguard the school's reputation and ensure that every rand is directed towards improving teaching and learning.

Essential Financial Records for Principals

To maintain a clear audit trail and demonstrate compliance with their duty to prevent mismanagement, the principal must ensure the SGB maintains comprehensive and accurate financial records. These records are the backbone of accountability and transparency.

1. Primary Source Documents

These documents track the original flow of money and must be complete:

- Receipt Books: Official, numbered receipts must be issued for all income (school fees, fundraising).
- Invoices and Purchase Orders (POs): Detailed, approved invoices must support all expenditures. POs should be used to commit funds before the purchase is made.
- Bank Deposit Slips and Proof of Payments: Evidence that money received was banked promptly and that money spent was properly transferred (EFT records).
- Delivery Notes: Documentation confirming that goods or services paid for have actually been received.

2. Accounting Records and Ledgers

These records summarise the primary documents into an understandable financial picture:

- Cash Books/Journals: The critical daily record tracking all money received and paid out, categorised by date and type.
- Asset Register: A detailed list of all fixed assets (e.g., computers, equipment), requiring regular physical verification to prevent loss.
- School Fee Register: A detailed record tracking outstanding fees, payments, and arrangements with parents.

3. Financial Reporting and Governance Records

These documents prove that the oversight functions are being performed:

- Approved Annual Budget: The foundation against which all expenditures are measured.
- Monthly Financial Statements/Reports: Concise reports (e.g., Bank Reconciliation Statements and Statements of Financial Performance) that the principal must review monthly for unusual trends.
- SGB Minutes: Minutes must clearly record all financial decisions, expenditure approvals, and, crucially, the principal's advice or concerns as required by Section 16A.

The Principal as Custodian of Integrity

Section 16A reminds us that a principal's role is not just administrative, but moral. Principals are custodians of public funds entrusted for the education and welfare of learners. Mismanagement — whether through negligence or intent — ultimately harms learners by diverting resources away from teaching, learning, and school improvement.

Good financial management is therefore not merely a compliance exercise; it is an act of **educational leadership**. It reflects a principal's commitment to accountability, fairness, and the long-term sustainability of the school.

A Call to Responsible Leadership

The lessons from cases of financial mismanagement are clear: prevention is far better than correction. Principals who lead with integrity, maintain strong internal controls, and build financially literate teams ensure that every rand serves its rightful purpose — improving the quality of education.

As custodians of both trust and public funds, let us reaffirm our commitment to transparency and good governance. After all, the way we manage money in our schools today reflects the values we want our learners to carry into the future.
