is provided that will impact on teaching and learning practice, and that no classroom is left without a teacher during contact time.

While the teaching of reading and mathematics continues to receive specific focus in the GET Band during 2023, the teacher

development programmes on offer for the GET and FET phases have been expanded to include several other subjects.

Teachers, therapists, practitioners, school managers, subject advisors and district officials within the province are encouraged to

participate in the training programmes scheduled for 2023/24 which are appropriate to them and will lead to improved learning outcomes. Registration links will be issued by the four PTDIs to enable interested persons to register to attend trainings of their choice

and circuit managers, subject advisors are encouraged to refer persons to trainings appropriate to such individuals.

# MESSAGE FROM THE OFFICE OF THE CHIEF DIRECTOR: TEACHER DEVELOPMENT AND LEARNING INSTITUTIONS

This prospectus for 2023 – 2024 has been drawn up with input from the Curriculum Chief Directorate; Inclusive Education; IDS & G. Our partners in education such as NECT, Teacher Unions and Higher Education Institutions have also given us their training programmes.

Training has been scheduled for school holidays and during school terms. Holiday training may last for 3 to 5 days while training during the school term has been scheduled for a maximum of two days. We expect schools to make the necessary arrangement to cover for teachers who attend training during school time.

Certain training has been repeated to allow PTDIs and Districts to train more teachers during the repeat sessions should training targets not be achieved the first time.

Please note that while it is expected at most, if not all, training as shown in this Prospectus will take place, certain competing priorities of the Eastern Cape Department of Education, may force Institutes to postpone some training to another date. In this regard, Institutes should keep a record of such postponed training and ensure the office of the Chief Directorate: Teacher Development & Learning Institutions of the Eastern Cape is kept informed of these changes as well as the new dates of the training.

Each Institute will also ensure that all registers are kept safely. Copies of registers and other relevant information are sent to the office of the Chief Directorate: Teacher Development & Learning Institutions of the Eastern Cape. A copy of the register, including the details of the training should also be sent to the South African Council of Educators (SACE) so that CPTD points are allocated to the teachers concerned.

We wish all teachers and officials a very happy and fruitful 2023 - 2024 training year
